

# Art Supplies

This list is suggested supplies only and you do not need to have everything on this list. Try to have a few of these things available to you during your session. Many of these supplies can be found at the dollar store.

## Paper and Surfaces

- Various sizes and colours
- Construction paper
- Cardstock
- Watercolour or mixed media paper
- Newsprint
- Printer paper
- Canvas
- Masonite boards
- Cardboard
- Tissue paper

## Paint

- Acrylic
- Watercolour or gouache
- Tempera or finger-paint



## Sticky Stuff

- Glue stick
- Glue (white or tacky etc.)
- Masking tape or painters tape

## Drawing Supplies

- Markers
- Pencil crayons
- Pens
- Pencils
- Oil pastels
- Chalk pastels
- Crayons



## Tools

- Scissors
- Stamps
- Stencils
- Paintbrushes in various sizes
- Cup for water
- Paper towels or a rag
- Palette, wax paper, or something else to put paint/glue on

## Bits and Pieces

- String/yarn
- 2 or 3 file folders
- Collage images (can be cut from magazines and newspapers, or printed out. Photocopies of photos or old photographs, maps, brochures, etc.)
- Craft supplies: feathers, beads, pipe cleaners, popsicle sticks, googly eyes, buttons, stickers, styrofoam balls/ plates/ trays, sequins, ribbon, glitter, etc.
